HOW TO DO IT:

-  Scan or manually enter the patient ID
-  Verify the correct patient name appears
-  Proceed with the medication and settings as ordered

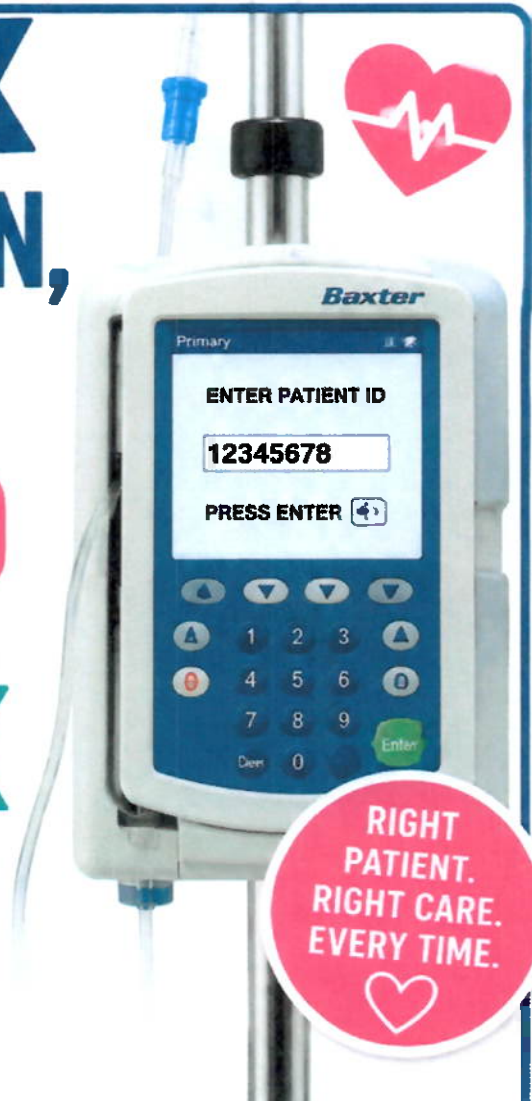
