### Changes to PowerPlans that Contain the 48 Hour Telemetry Order: Go-Live Ongoing

- The 48 Hour Telemetry order is being removed from the majority of PowerPlans to help eliminate unnecessary utilization of telemetry monitoring.
- The order remains in the HCA approved plans listed below:
