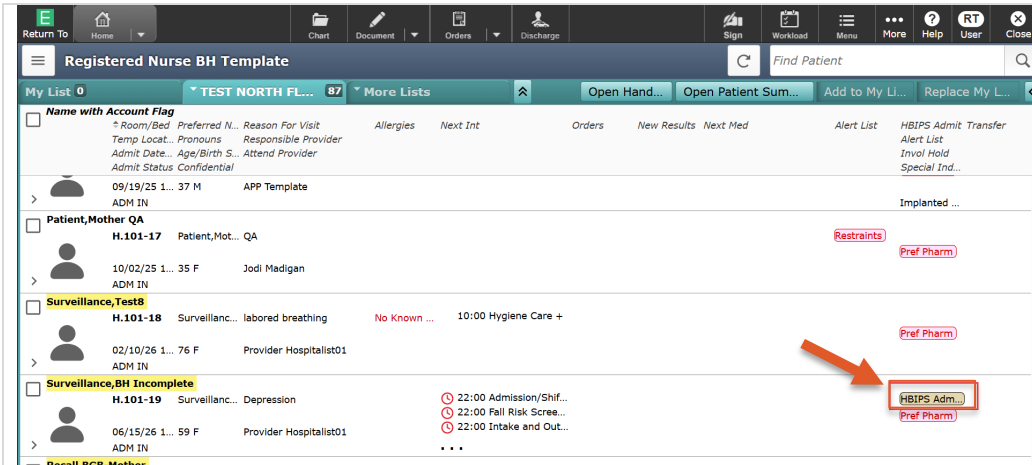

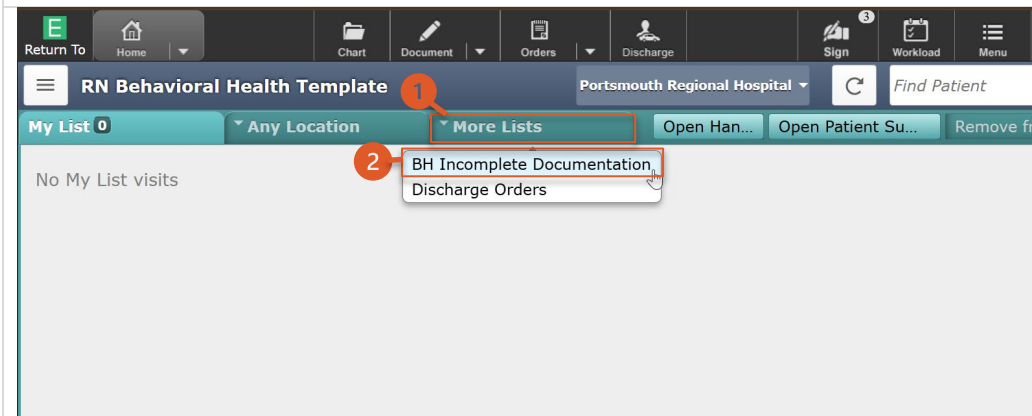
Surveillance- BH Incomplete Documentation status board

The Behavioral Health Incomplete Documentation status board flags patients missing certain behavioral health documentation elements, to more easily facilitate completion of incomplete documentation.



From the main Behavioral Health Nursing status board, HBIPS Admit Flags indicate patients missing certain behavioral health documentation.

When an HBIPS Admit Flag is displayed, the nurse should navigate to the BH Incomplete Documentation status Board to determine which documentation needs to be completed.



To navigate to the BH Incomplete Documentation status board, select

1. More Lists
2. BH Incomplete Documentation

The overlay displays:

1. Details regarding the profile, including which documentation should be completed to resolve the flag
2. Pertinent associated data
3. 'Take Action' links to the appropriate intervention(s) that need to be completed
4. Qualifying criteria, explaining why the patient qualifies for the profile

Note: Most flags on the BH Incomplete Documentation status board will no longer display, once screening documentation has been complete for the current visit. Exceptions are the Depression and BPRS screening flags, in the rightmost column. These screenings should be completed once, after admission, and again within 24 hours of discharge. The flags for these two screenings will indicate whether the screening needed is the admission requirement or requirement for repeat screening prior to discharge.

The associated intervention will open and allow the user to complete and save.

That screening flag will then drop for the patient, on the BH Incomplete Documentation status board, within 1-2 minutes of saving the documented responses, if all necessary documentation elements have been addressed for that requirement.
