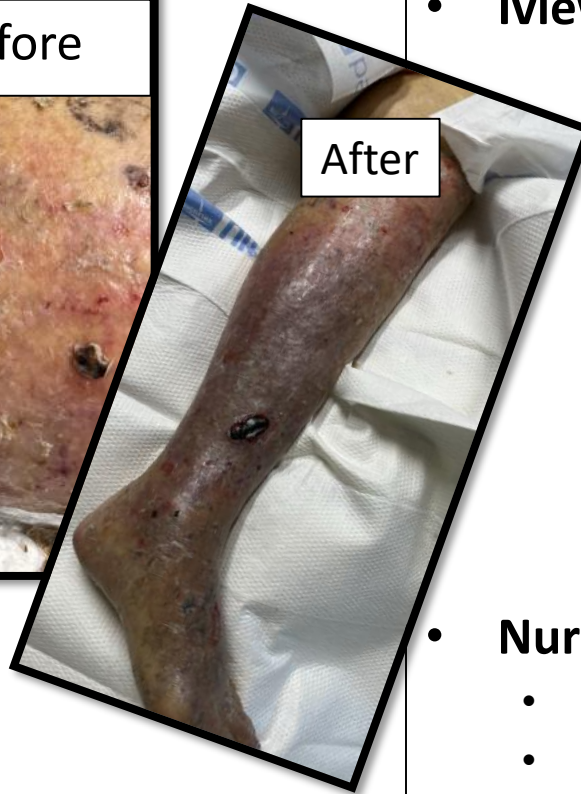

- Apply daily (not between toes)

Dressing, Change
Details:
Daily, see order comments
Order Comment:
Dry Crusted Skin or Thick Scales to Legs and/or Feet:
1. Wash with soap and water to help remove excess skin.
2. Apply moisturizing skin ointment liberally, not between toes.
3. Apply non-skid socks to feet before patient transfers or ambulates.
4. May apply ABD pads and/or roll gauze bandage if skin flaking is excessive
